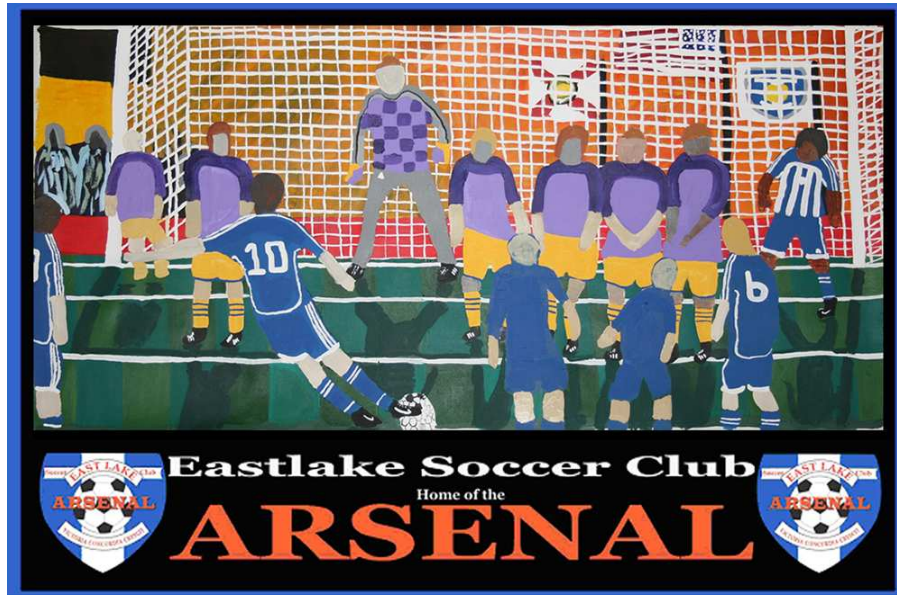




East Lake Soccer Association

His Grandfather is Nationally and Internationally known, and has been a professional painter for over 60 years. Cumming taught at the Cornish Art Institute in Seattle, and the Seattle Art Institute. He is the last surviving member of the "The Northwest School", and is associated with the big four in Northwest Art History- Morris Graves, Mark Tobey, Guy Anderson and Kenneth Callahan.
